

Band at John Paul II during 2025-2026!

This school year (2025-2026) the 4th grade through 8th grade students will have the opportunity to participate in after-school band. The John Paul II Band Program is small group music lessons on the instruments you would find in a high school marching band. There is no marching involved here. But a lot of fun. Students may choose from the following instruments:

Flute, Clarinet, Alto Saxophone, Trumpet, Trombone, Bells (xylophone), or Snare Drum. This band program is being brought to John Paul II by The Music Staff and therefore has a fee separate from tuition (please see below). Families are also responsible for the rental of the music instrument. Band begins in September. We will allow sign-ups through the month of September. Students who have participated in one or more years of band and are continuing on the same instrument are in Advanced <u>Band.</u> All students who are new to their chosen instrument are in the Beginner Band.

Eligible Students: Beginner Band: Any student, in 4th through 8th grade, who has not played the instrument before.

Advanced Band: Any student, in 5th - 8th grade, who has a year or more experience on the instrument.

Beginner Band = THURSDAY AFTER SCHOOL Advanced Band = TUESDAY AFTER SCHOOL Day of Band: Time: **Beginner Band** = 3:30 pm - 4:30 pm. Advanced Band = 3:30 pm - 4:30 pm.

Location: After School in the Music Room. Pick up: at the main doors of school between 4:30 pm and 4:40 pm. **Demonstration:** All instruments will be demonstrated to all 4th graders. You may also watch online demonstrations:

First Day of Band: Beginner Band = THURSDAY, Sept 4th. Advanced Band = TUESDAY, Sept 2nd. Continues through May 14, 2026. Fees: Band fees are collected twice during the school year. (The form below does give the option to pay the year in full.)

One Child in Band = \$250, which is collected now and again in January 2026.

Two or More Children in Band from the same family = \$440, which is collected now & in January 2026.

Reasons why your 4th grade through 8th grade student should consider After-School Band offered at JPII during the 2025-26 year:

- 1. JPII will offer band after school on **Thursdays for Beginners** (and Tuesdays for Advanced).
- 2. During Band, your student will **learn how to play an instrument**, and your student will also learn a new language: **The language of reading music!**



- 3. Band offers the opportunity for **self-expression**, **creativity and achievement**. In our era of instant gratification, nothing beats learning and playing a musical instrument, which provides the **instant gratification** of learning new notes, new rhythms, and new theory.
- 4. Band allows the student to **explore past worlds and various cultures** by learning songs from different times and places around the globe.
- 5. Band participation enhances **problem-solving**, provides the setting for **teamwork**, **goal-setting**, **coordination**, and **improved memory skills**. Band participation also boosts self-confidence, self-esteem, and concentration. It helps improve the executive function!
- 6. Band offers the opportunity to make shared family experiences and memories.
- 7. Band is a **performing art**, practiced daily at home, "team" practice weekly during after-school band class, and provides the venue for two performances during the school year.
